ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Operate and maintain machinery to fabricate and assemble components
- Perform repetitive jobs on a production floor warehouse setting
- Ability to lift heavy objects and stand for extended periods during shifts

- Strong attention to detail and commitment to producing quality work
- Assist in the movement of materials within the warehouse as needed
- Excellent communication skills and ability to work well in a team-oriented environment
- Follow all safety protocols and maintain a clean work environment while adapting to different workstations as needed
- Perform quality checks on products to ensure they meet specifications
- Assist in loadout and shipping and receiving areas as necessary for large shipments
